

Iniquity, Transgression & Sin [Part 3]

Text

Isa 53:1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

Isa 53:2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

Isa 53:3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

*Isa 53:4 Surely, **he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.***

*Isa 53:5 **But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.***

*Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and **the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.***

Isa 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

*Isa 53:8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: **for the transgression of my people was he stricken.***

Isa 53:9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

*Isa 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when **thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin**, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.*

*Isa 53:11 He shall see of the travail of his soul and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for **he shall bear their iniquities.***

*Isa 53:12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and **he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many**, and made intercession for the transgressors.*

II. **Meaning of Iniquity [See Servant of Messiah Ministries]**

H5771: Avon

G458: Anomia

(Iniquity): perversity, that is, (moral) evil:

- a. Thus **sin**, when **repeated** against the **knowledge of God**, becomes **transgression** which, if it continues long enough, **eventually becomes iniquity** which **perverts** the **flesh**.
- b. This perversion **changes the DNA/RNA structure** of the "**flesh**" and "**beliefs**" or "**attitudes**" resulting in **genetic changes** that are **passed on** from **generation to generation**.
- c. This is the way **high blood pressure, alcoholism, sexual perversions, jealousy, anger, fear**, etc. are passed down from **generation to generation**. **Racism, Greed, Idolatry run in families. Likewise, homosexuality**
- d. Iniquity is an attitude so **cannot just be covered over with blood**. It must be **taken away and replaced**. David prayed for a new heart and a right Spirit:

Psa 51:9 Hide thy face from my sins and **blot out all mine iniquities**.

Psa 51:10 **Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.**

Psa 51:11 **Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.**

- e. **Iniquity reinforces our inherited sin nature [flesh], causing us to be cast away from His presence and being denied the Holy Spirit**

III. **Effects of Temptations**

Gen 3:6

- Tree was good for food ---Sin
- Pleasing to the eye ---Transgression
- Desirable for gaining wisdom ---Iniquity

1Jn2:16

- Lust of the flesh ---Sin
- Lust of the eyes ---Transgression
- Pride of life ---Iniquity

IV. **Effects on Spirit, Soul & Body**

Sin	➔	Soul
Transgression	➔	Body
Iniquity	➔	Spirit

V. The Day of Atonement

Lev 16:7 And he shall take the two goats and present them before the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Lev 16:8 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats; one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat.

*Lev 16:9 And **Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD'S lot fell, and offer him for a sin offering***

Lev 16:15 Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

*Lev 16:16 And **he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness.***

*Lev 16:21 **And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:***

*Lev 16:22 And the goat shall bear upon him **all their iniquities** unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.*

- a. One goat for a sin offering
- b. Its blood to be sprinkled on the Mercy Seat to atone for uncleanness
- c. The second goat: Aaron to lay his hands on its head and confess the sins, transgressions & iniquities of the people and send it to the wilderness

VI. Messiah's Atonement

- a. Carried our diseases: Isa 53:4
- b. Wounded for our transgressions Isa 53:5
- c. Bruised for our iniquities: Isa 53:5
- d. Was our sin offering: Isa 53:10
- e. After He rose from the dead, Yahshua cleansed the Heavenly Ark with His blood and purged our conscience from dead works [uncleanness]—

Heb 9:11 But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;

*Heb 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but **by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place**, having obtained eternal redemption for us.*

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Heb 9:14 How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**

Note:

1. Sin affects the soul: hence Yahshua's soul had to become an offering for sin. His soul went to hell for 3 days & 3 nights while His body lay in the tomb.
2. Transgression represents breaking the Torah: hence Yahshua was wounded [break in the skin] for our transgressions
3. A bruise is a discoloration of the skin indicating a deep wound: iniquities impact our spirit. Yashua was bruised for our iniquities

VII. **Sanctification**

1Th 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- a. A saint: sanctified one
- b. Must be sanctified wholly: spirit, soul & body
- c. To be blameless
