### Text

**1Co 6:9** Know ye not that **the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God?**  
*Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,*

**1Co 6:10** *Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.*

**1Co 6:11** *And such were some of you: **but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.***

**1Co 6:12** *All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but **I will not be brought under the power of any.***

### I. Unrighteous cannot inherit the Kingdom

From G1 (as a negative particle) and G1349; unjust; by extension wicked; by implication treacherous; specifically heathen: - unjust, unrighteous.

### II. Washed [Being Washed]

**Eph 5:25** *Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;*

**Eph 5:26** **That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,**

**Eph 5:27** **That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.**

**Joh 3:3** *Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.***

**Joh 3:4** *Nicodemus saith unto him, how can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?*

**Joh 3:5** *Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.***

- a. See: know, understand
- b. Born of water: washing of water by the Word

### III. Sanctified [Holiness]

**Luk 1:74** *That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,*

Luk 1:75 **In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.**

Heb 10:10 By the which will **we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.**

1Th 5:23 And **the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

Joh 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be **sanctified through the truth.**

- a. Live in holiness
- b. By His Blood
- c. Wholly

#### IV. **Justified**

Rom 3:30 Seeing **it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.**

Rom 3:31 Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

Gal 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, **The just shall live by faith.**

- a. Justified by faith
- b. Live by faith

#### V. **Forgiving**

Heb 12:14 **Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:**

Heb 12:15 Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled

#### VI. **Doing His Will**

Mar 3:34 And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!

Mar 3:35 For **whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.**

Mat 7:21 **Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.**

Mat 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

*Mat 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*

**1Jn 2:16** *For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.*

*1Jn 2:17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: **but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.***

- a. To be His relative
- b. To enter Heaven

## VII. **Faith Vs Unbelief**

**Heb 3:7** *Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, today if ye will hear his voice, Heb 3:8 Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:*

*Heb 3:9 When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years.*

*Heb 3:10 Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, they do always err in their heart; and they have not known my ways.*

*Heb 3:11 So I swore in my wrath, they shall not enter into my rest.)*

*Heb 3:12 **Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.***

*Heb 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.*

## VIII. **Obedying His Word**

**Rom 6:15** What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

**Rom 6:16 **Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?****

**Rom 6:17** But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

**Rom 6:18** Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

**Note: our choice**—sin unto death or obedience unto righteousness

## IX. **Investing Talents**

**Mat 25:24** *Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art a hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:*

*Mat 25:25 And I was afraid and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.*

*Mat 25:26 His lord answered and said unto him, thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:*

*Mat 25:27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.*

*Mat 25:28 Take therefore the talent from him and give it unto him which hath ten talents.*

*Mat 25:29 For unto everyone that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.*

*Mat 25:30 **And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.***

#### X. **Faithfulness**

*Rev 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are **called, and chosen, and faithful.***

#### XI. **Paradox: Free & Costly**

*Luk 14:33 So likewise, **whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.***

#### XII. **Wedding Garment: Righteous Acts**

*Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.*

*Rev 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for **the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.***

*Mat 22:11 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment:*

*Mat 22:12 And he saith unto him, **Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.***

*Mat 22:13 Then said the king to the servants, **bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.***

*Mat 22:14 **For many are called, but few are chosen.***

- a. Bride and guests must have wedding garments
- b. Many are called [invited] but few are chosen [elect]
